I am writing to object to the de-designation of Green Belt land for housing and other purposes. The Green Belt was created to stop the spread of cities and give the city dwellers a reasonable journey to allow them to reach the countryside. To take it away seems to me like infringing their Human Rights. The people of Enfield and Hertfordshire have also got used to the Garden Centres in Crews Hill and will feel that this development will also impact on their lifestyle,

I would also like to point out that the proposed development would also increase traffic onto the already busy main roads thus making it almost impossible for anybody to travel anywhere ,especially to Enfield Town, Cuffley or Cheshunt where the roads are already busy and extremely so at anytime after 3 o'clock.

There doesn't seem to be any mention of the infrastructure required. By that I mean Doctors' Surgeries, Hospital places and School places, where the current facilities are fully occupied at the moment.

We have already lost one golf course, probably permanently and it looks like we are going to lose another. Where are the new families going to find places to play golf in Enfield as well as the existing members of Crews Hill Golf Club. There are also several footpaths crossing the land mentioned and a loss of sports facilities. Where are the Enfield residents going to be able to exercise when they are no longer there.

Finally what is proposed seems to make Enfield move from being the Greenest Borough in London to the most polluted what with LTNs, Cycle Lanes and now the Local plan; and what about the effect on Climate Change as there will be much less open land, vegetation and tree coverage available
