Personally we had to send our children to school in Palmers Green as there were no places in the school within walking distance of our house, so I have been driving my children to school every day from Southgate to Palmers Green for 9 years! Another example: My sister in law lives right behind the Sainsburys in Winchmore Hill, she could not get a local school place and is having to drive her daughter to a primary school much further away' every day which is hugely stressful for two full time working parents.
