

Local Plan - Site SA45 – Land between Camlet Way and Crescent West, Hadley Wood**OBJECTION**

In this new world of increasingly regular disastrous environmental events, it is abundantly clear that we are at a critical point in a globally acknowledged climate crisis. So, I question the logic and level of responsibility in the entertainment of such a proposal that is nothing short of a catastrophic destruction of countryside to include every living creature that calls it home.

This land and its trees is alive with an array of wildlife, rich and diverse. There is muntjac, rabbits, owls and foxes, not to mention bats and birds of prey. More recently there are also green parrots nesting in the trees. I question how on earth would it be acceptable to tear this apart and destroy the homes of so many creatures.

This plan to destroy the rarity of green space within London with yet another huge over-development of 160 homes on green belt land, will have irreversible effects on the village appeal and quaintness of the area. This will be no face-lift, it will not be sustainable development, it will be a monstrosity and an epic fail.

Local Plan does not have a settlement hierarchy or prioritisation of brownfield sites. The Council has surprisingly not included their landholdings or estates.

Please let it be noted that I strongly object to the proposed release of this green belt site and the site allocation.
