Objection to SA32, Sainsburys Green Lanes N21 3RS. Page 351 of Enfield Local Plan. Redevelopment of supermarket and car park to mixed-used homes and non-residential floor space

I would like to register my objection to the proposed redevelopment of the site currently used by Sainsbury's in Winchmore Hill.

It would be a disaster for the community and for myself personally.

From a personal perspective I live walking distance from Sainsbury's and have used the store ever since I moved to the area 5 years ago. I walk down there regularly with my girls who cycle or scoot and enjoy using the park on the way. I use the store for shopping, recycling and the pharmacy. It is a great facility and a pleasant route to get there.

Overall from a community perspective I object for the following main reasons:

- the green space surrounding the site is unusual in the area and home to rich wildlife as well as being used by the volcano community
- while housing is needed, there is no provision for other infrastructure to support it and so more pressure will be put on roads, doctors and schools
- the supermarket provides a range of services that serve the community including the pharmacy and is very well used
