All 299 flat owners will at least have one car to add to the normal congestion. Taken into account the cars of the flat owners/renters of the new development of the former government building less than 1/2 mile away, I would like to know if a serious consultation has been taken place of the impact this will have, not only on the traffic on Green Lanes, but on all the streets around this area.

Also, parking for shoppers at Sainsbury's have free parking at the moment, and with parking spaces so rare that you need more than good luck to find one, this is an intolerable future we can look forward to.
