I write to object in no uncertain terms to the proposed plans for building on the site of Sainsburys, N21 3RS.

- 1. The loss of facilities and amenity will be catastrophic over a wide area, particularly for elderly residents, people with young children and the wider working population.
- 2. Housing on the site will increase air pollution in the area and exacerbate traffic density in the Green Lanes and surrounding areas
- 3. The loss of green space, providing a green lung in the middle of a densely populated area and much used by local residents is inexcusable. Due to the effects of climate change, ALL green places should be preserved at all costs to help increase oxygen levels to combat rising CO2 and pollution generally.
- 4. The site is inappropriate anyway because it can only provide minimal cramped housing.
- 5. Surely one housing solution would be to demolish areas of sub-standard housing and build modern new communities where residents have clean air to breathe.
