I have looked at your proposed "Enfield Draft Local Plan" and I object strongly with the proposal to

build crematoriums at either Firs Farm (SA59) or Church Street Recreation Ground (SA61) sites.

Both sites seem totally inappropriate given that they are both near residential areas and

in the case of Church Street a school as well. Increased air pollution would result and access

to the proposed Firs Farm Crematorium would be hindered due to road width barriers and road speed humps.

Given you say there is a problem with the number of burial sites in Enfield I fail to see the need for another crematorium

if more people are preferring burial why do you need another crematorium when Enfield already has an existing large crematorium.

I also object to the proposal regarding the existing Sainsbury's Supermarket in Green Lanes, Winchmore Hill (SA32)

If this supermarket is closed it would mean a car journey to another supermarket surely not in the interests of

climate change. Building nearly 300 homes on the site would probably create more traffic problems and pollution

in Green Lanes which already suffers from stop start traffic caused by the introduction of the barely used cycle lane.
