

Objection to SA32, Sainsburys Green Lanes N21 3RS. Page 351 of Enfield Local Plan: Redevelopment of supermarket and car park to mixed-use homes and non-residential floor space.

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I am writing to object to draft policy as shown above, because:

- The loss of a major supermarket in the area will force people to have to drive further to an equivalent supermarket, with consequent impact of additional / longer car journeys.
- Without any supporting planned community infrastructure this will lead to an overstretch of existing facilities such as schools, doctors' surgeries etc.
- The increase in vehicles on the road from relating to the development, will increase CO2 emissions which will adversely impact local residents
- This development will lead to the destruction of habitat and woodlands
- The green space is especially useful for residents who live in the surrounding flats and do not have gardens • The area is used by families and elderly alike, which contributes to the health and wellbeing of all residents of Enfield

I hope the council will reconsider this proposal and remove all reference to it in the Local Plans.

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
