Objection to SA32, Sainsburys Green Lanes N21 3RS. Page 351 of Enfield Local Plan: Redevelopment of supermarket and car park to mixed - use homes and non-residential floor space.

I have already responded to your questionnaire which I think illustrates totally your lack of care for the residents of Enfield. I have lived in the Borough for 34 years and I could not believe the suggestion in SA32 as described above, so am responding separately to this.
