We STRONGLY object to the above mentioned proposal, for the following reasons;

- 1. The loss of this supermarket will have a great impact on the many residents who rely on local amenities as they do not have cars especially the elderly and disabled
- Increase car usage on local roads.
   The increase in vehicles on the road from local residents forced to drive further and potential residents of the development will increase carbon monoxide levels which will impact locals especially children at Highfields School
- 3. Increase of traffic along the main roads will force drivers to use side roads which will have an enormous impact on noise and air pollution
- 4. The development will lead to destruction of habitat, Woodlands and community space. An area which is used by many and contributes to the health and wellbeing of all residents
- 5. Outstretch of existing facilities such as doctors surgeries, dentists, nurseries and schools. This year Highfields School received 400 applications for 100 places.
- 6. Lack of parking space for local residents and amenities leading to loss of revenue to local shops and closures
