

I am writing to strongly protest about the above proposed plan. Do you know how dispiriting and difficult it is to drive around Enfield's roads already? The loss of this supermarket, which I use almost daily, would force me and hundreds of other people to drive further afield to shop, therefore increasing traffic on our already blocked roads.

Schools, doctors surgeries and dentists will become even more overloaded, it's nigh on impossible at the moment to get a doctors appt and I work in a school so I know the pressures there!

The potential increase in vehicles on the road will, lead to higher carbon monoxide levels which have increased anyway because of the lunacy of the LTN,s.

This development will lead to destruction of habitat and woodlands, the site is home to at least three species of woodpecker, as well as trees with protection orders. Nobody ever seems to care about our green spaces and the wildlife which has just as much right to live as we do.

This development will lead to an over development of the area given the recent and future developments along Green Lanes - Travis Perkins, Capitol House etc. There will be massive vehicle disruption and increases building work traffic on an already congested road.
