Totally opposed to this. It will mean that shoppers will have to travel further meaning more cars, more congestion, pollution. Green Lanes is already an extremely busy road, further problems created by more cars. Parking is not great now and at the best of times.

Alternative, why not leave Sainsbury where it, it has been there for a very long time and build on top, no more than 2/3 storeys maximum. Although I'm totally opposed to tall buildings being very high it would solve some of the housing shortage but of course doesn't solve the above I mentioned with cars etc.

The nearest Sainsbury is Highlands but that is a small store not stocking equivalent to N21 store. The other one is on the A10 on the retail park, so very much further. I can assure you people wont travel by cycle to the store further away.

The car is NEVER going to go away. Leave the N21 store where it is.
