Investing in Enfield green spaces and addressing climate change Enfield Council's Draft Local Plan provides specific protection for our rich network of biodiversity, our ancient woodlands and our commitment to be a carbon neutral borough by 2040. It will also support our plans to enhance access to green spaces and invest further in our existing parks.

I would like to contribute to the plan which I have read in relation to Painter Lane Open Space.

I have lived in the borough for my whole life and in my home for 30 years.

Painters Lane Open Space is used by the local community and could benefit from some very basic enhancements which would improve the area and ensure that all residents can use this space.

I am in the process of setting up a Friends Group (The process is very difficult and timely but I am progressing). Whilst this will allow me to organise projects I think the council should be organising the basics that are required for this open to space to work for the community in the best possible way.

- The area should be fenced and entrances should have gates.
- The park should have paved paths for use by people with wheelchairs and prams.
- The area should have a notice board for relevant messages.
- The area should have more rubbish bins
- The area should have the rubbish removed more regularly.
- The area should have more seating and some tables.
- The area needs to have litter removed from the hedges and trees.
- The area needs to have the hedges cut back and cleared.
- The area needs better lighting
- The area needs CCTV
- The area could have a separate dog area.
- Trees could be planted.
- Regular Community police patrols.
