Access to Local Facilities & Congestion

- The loss of a major supermarket in the area will force people to have to drive further. This would especially affect elderly and disabled residents and increase car usage on local roads.
- No supporting community infrastructure planned which will lead to an overstretch of existing facilities such as schools, doctors' surgeries etc.

Environment

- The green space is especially useful for residents who live in the surrounding flats and do not have gardens. The council is also proposing to build a Crematorium on the neighbouring Wet Land playing fields
- Our surrounding green spaces have been a safe haven and opportunity to relax and reconnect with nature during the pandemic. An incredibly valuable tool to help maintain healthy bodies and minds.

Mostly I object to the erosion of our green spaces - the value of which seem to be over looked. I would feel much more comfortable to see a plan which shows exactly where we will be protecting green spaces instead of just squeezing in as many residential and commercial proprieties as possible.
