The concerns over the inappropriate use of brownfield and greenfield sites are huge. The type of housing and the environments are inappropriate and make little us of in filling and regenerating sites. The reliance on cars due to a poor transport infrastructure is unsustainable. The housing for the younger independent workforce and key workers is unaffordable so subject to vastly inflated opportunities for renting. Investing in Enfield needs to be a bottom up approach, making it the greener individual borough it used to be not a massive housing estate with poorly thought out infrastructure
