I have seen many changes some of them great some of them very poor but this latest idea of turning the town centre into a warren of housing is the last straw. There is a multitude of evidence that high rise in density does not work it provides poor accommodation increased crime and social disturbance. It is not not suitable for Enfield town. Do not put this forward as a support for government housing requirements it is not an appropriate place. Newtowns are the answer for the number of properties required not overcrowding existing towns. There are plenty of good examples around. Simply follow the examples!!
