**Local Plan - Site SA45 – Land between Camlet Way and Crescent West, Hadley Wood**

I have lived in Hadley Wood for over 3 years and one of the reasons my mum chose to live here in Hadley Wood was because of the green fields. This site forms part of a stunning landscape that goes well beyond the borough boundary. I am very saddened by the prospect of losing this valuable green belt asset for development.

I, therefore, wish to **strongly object** to the proposed release of this green belt site and the site allocation, which would allow the development of 160 homes on green belt land for the following reasons:

**This is an unnecessary large scale destruction of Green Belt**

**Increased housing in Hadley Wood is not ‘sustainable development’**

**The Local Plan fails to develop/prioritise all brownfield sites**

**The Site is surrounded by Conservation Areas and Grade II listed**

**No evidence why the Area of Special Character is no longer appropriate**
