i am writing with regard to the future redevelopments by Enfield Council.

The Council has already passed planning permission for flats to be built on the Colosseum Retail Park for up to 1,800 residential units, one of which will be 29 storeys. This development

alone will put extra traffic on the two busiest roads in Enfield (A10 and Southbury Road). If

the redevelopment was to go ahead to build on the Sainsbury, Morrison and Tesco sites the roads will be grid locked. Then the next move for the Council will be to make all roads in Enfield

permit holder, putting more money into their coffers.

Enfield needs more employment not less, and as for the Council getting £3,500 per job lost that

money should go to the people that will lose their jobs. Where do they think Enfield residents

will go shopping, at the moment these are in walking distance for those that do not have cars.

There is already a massive development going on at the moment on land at Chase Farm, have

the Council made provisions for extra schools to accommodate these children. School spaces

are already stretched to the limit in the Borough. The Council have already taken land from the

Park to extend George Spicers and Kingsmead, this land was bequeathed to the people of Enfield for playing fields.

With the closure of Chase Farm A & E, pressure has been put on Barnet and North Mid A & E.

with at times Ambulances being diverted to Barnet, I have experience of this when my husband

was critically ill, the Ambulance was diverted to Barnet, he was in an anti-room for over 2 hours

before entering the A&E department and was seen by a Junior Doctor as the Consultants were

so busy with other patients, sadly my husband died to days later. This was five years ago and I'm sure with more families moving into Enfield the situation has not changed.

Even before the pandemic it was getting harder to get a doctors appointment, how are they going to cope with these extra residents as we have a shortage of doctors.

This Council seems to be determined to destroy our Borough not just for the residents, but for the future residents. Enfields roads and infrastructure will not be able to cope.

As a lifetime Labour voter the next Council Elections can not come quick enough for me to

change my vote.
