
To whom it may concern,
With regard to plans to build a crematorium on or near Firs Farm Wetlands, I would like to strongly voice my objections on the following grounds:

- Firstly, much time, money and effort has gone into the creation of the Wetlands. They have been a great success, having attracted an abundance of wildlife. Is all that work to be wasted? During lockdown, huge numbers of people walked there daily to look after their mental health.
- The site is not appropriate for a crematorium, being flanked by so many schools: Firs Farm Primary, Highfields, Winchmore, and Latymer just across the A10. Their air quality will be affected by the increase in emissions and the reduction in green space
- A crematorium will bring increased traffic to the area, which again is an issue for the schools and the neighbourhood.
- There is a crematorium a few miles up the A10. Could a solution be found whereby the capacity there could be increased?
- The quality of air on this side of the borough is already affected by the Edmonton incinerator. This would be intolerable. It would be too close to housing and schools.
