To whom it may concern,

I am writing to strenuously object against the plans to redevelop greenbelt land along with local conveniences into housing and other services, specifically the re-development of a number of local supermarkets, the conversion' of the recreation fields at Firs Farm and to the east of the A10 (south of Church Street) for crematorium use and, permitted tall building in many locations of the Borough including at Enfield Town station (up to 51m, 17 storeys)
