I have lived in the Hadley Wood area for over forty years, attending local schools as a child and bringing up two children in the process.

I am a member of the Hadleywood association and use the facilities and amenities within Hadley wood. I urge you to dismiss the proposal to release this beautiful section of land which is precious Green Belt that has historical status.

This proposal would forever change the special positive character of Hadley wood to an over developed area with no infrastructure to support this increase in Housing.

The Green Belt is supposed to protect overdevelopment and releasing this land would be a travesty and destructive to future generations enjoyment.

There is plenty of brown field sites that should be developed instead with adequate infrastructure already in place. Hadley Wood has no infrastructure that can absorb proposed development, traffic is already a nightmare, schools are full, lack of shops and public transportation.

This would mean all householders would have to drive everywhere causing more pollution and added dangers to pedestrians.
