> I am writing to object to the proposal of redevelopment of supermarket and car park to mixed use homes and no residential floor space SA 32 page 351 of Enfield local plan.

> The loss of a major supermarket in the area will force people to drive further and increase car usage in local road. There will also be a wider impacts on the environment, traffic and local infrastructure.
