

I would like to object that Enfield Council's consideration to build on green belt land especially in the Crews Hill area.

I have lived and worked in Enfield for over 70yrs and have enjoyed all that the green belt has benefited me and would like to think that my children and my children's children would continue to benefit with all that the green belt offers.

There is no reason for the council to build on green belt land when there is vast areas of brownfields sites available. The only reason that can be drawn from this decision is financial where green belt land for Developers and Enfield Council would be more vastly profitable than brownfields sites.

This is not an exercise of building houses on land that is available but more so building houses on land that is more profitable.

The Mayor of London, Sadiq Khan, is totally against building on green belt land. Enfield Council should also be totally against building on green belt land.
