I am writing to confirm my objection to the development on the green belt land in Enfield, more specifically the 3,000 new houses on the land referred to as "Chase Park" also known as Vicarage Farm on the open Green Belt countryside next to Trent Park either side of the A110 (Enfield Road) between Oakwood and Enfield town (**Policy SP PL 10, pages 80-87, and Figure 3.11**).

My objection to this is based on many points as follows:

- 1. This is suburban land out of the heart of the City of London where we enjoy and reek the benefits of cleaner air and better health by having such green belt land in our surroundings. By taking away this green belt land for development you are dramatically affecting the health of the local residents by destroying the natural environment.
