As resident of Winchmore Hill for 30 years and long time customer the local Winchmore Hill Sainsburys store, I strongly object to plans to re-develop the store with almost 300 dwellings added to the site. My objection is based on the recent housing developments in the N21 area, for example the Flats on the Capitol House New River site, and the possible plans for the old Travis Perkins site which will bring a lot more people/families and traffic (both Construction and Private) in to the area.

My concerns are for the lack of community infrastructure to support these projects, Schools, Nurseries, Doctors and Dentist Surgeries Public transport, parking and public open spaces.
