My comments relate mainly to section 8.2.2 where building is permissible on "derelict and unslightly" green belt. The areas around Chase and Crews Hill are most definitely not derelict and unsightly, and choosing them for huge developments will spoil entirely the open spaces within the borough that can be enjoyed by people of all ages. The proposed development of tower blocks within Enfield Town completely overshadows the historical and architectural significance of the area. This cannot be a fitting development within the centre of the borough, which hopes to attract businesses and visitors because of its "market town" appeal. In addition, the proposed housing development does not recognise the actual need in housing for more family based units, not tower blocks.
