

I am writing to object to proposed developments in Winchmore Hill.

1.Sainsburys site. Where do people shop if this development goes ahead. It is a much used shopping source for a wide area. Also when the council gave permission for the supermarket to be built it was with the proviso that a large green area would be kept for wild life and the use of people as an open space e.g. the flats butting the grounds there.

2.Fords Grove car park. This was promised to the shops at Winchmore Hill Broadway when the cycle lane took away a number of parking spaces.
