I understand from [this tweet](#) from your council leader that the draft local plan classifies at least one of the borough's golf courses as suitable for housing.

I think this is an excellent move - golf is a sport which reserves a vast quantity of land for a tiny number of people, in a manner that is utterly indefensible at a time of housing shortage. Enfield currently has seven golf courses: reducing that number to four or five could help meet the area's housing need, without genuinely disadvantaging anybody.
