OBJECTION TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF GREEN BELT LAND BETWEEN CAMLET WAY AND CRESCENT WEST HADLEY WOOD

I have been a resident in the Hadley Wood area for a number of years and would like to register my objections to this proposed development. As a family we truly value the green space and peace that this area provides us with and a key reason we chose to reside here.

In summary my key reasons for objection:

The destruction of a green belt area is in my view totally wrong. We will be destroying a historic and valuable part of our borough and losing the immense benefit of the green spaces on our doorstep. This plan seems to contradict the declaration by the Council of a Climate Emergency.

I think it's totally incorrect to think this can be a sustainable site. The scheme would rely on a vast use of resident cars and local transport daily - especially given there are few local schools, few amenities within walking distance etc.

The site is also surrounded by a number of listed buildings on Camlet Way – any development such as this would adversely affect the setting, character and general appearance of the neighbourhood – I feel this is a massive negative for the area and for existing residents.

I would strongly push for the council to reject this proposal and look at other areas for development, certainly outside of this green belt area.
