I have the following comments to make on the document:

SA32: Sainsburys, Green Lanes

Although I am not completely opposed to this proposal, I wouldn't want to see a huge and well used supermarket move from this site and area. I am aware that a supermarket could remain on site, as well as building some housing. This would obviously be a preference. What does concern me is that along with building 299 new homes there has to be the community infrastructure provided to support this. Local schools, doctors surgeries and dentists are already overstretched in the area, and as a local resident I am fully aware and affected by this. Community infrastructure is needed in the area if a development of this scale is to be considered.

SA59: Firs Farm Recreation Ground

It is sad to see that there is a proposal for a crematorium use on this beautiful and well used parkland. Since the Firs Farm Wetland and circular path has been created it has been a popular destination for people within the Borough of Enfield. It is a great example of what the community, Council and other organisations can create together to improve people's wellbeing and the environment. I object to the idea of any part of the site being used for crematorium use when I feel the Council should be striving to improve the parkland further by incorporating facilities such as a cafe, toilets, education facilities, sports and fitness facilities etc.

I look forward to the next round of community engagement and consultation and hope that my above comments will have been taken on board and be reflected in the next version of the document.
