

Dear planners,

I am writing to object to the planned destruction of greenbelt land as detailed in the planning application outlined above.

My connection to the area is strong, having been married at St Paul's in Hadley Wood and loving seeing my children play on the recreation grounds around Crescent West.

The primary objection I hold is three-fold:

- The proposal threatens a **conservation area** with a unique heritage landscape set firmly in green belt land
- The proposed development is **not suitable for the planned or existing infrastructure** in the area, with an inadequate volume of school places, a lack of access to medical services and highly deficient access to public transport
- The environmental impact of any development would be significant and is not adequately catered for in the proposals, with significantly increased flooding risk, a large expected increase in traffic pollution and an enormous carbon footprint

I oppose these plans in the most heartfelt manner.
