I am writing to object to the planned development at Sainsburys Green Lanes (the above mentioned draft local plan SA32 p 315, p 359).

The proposed development (particularly tall flat blocks) would not be in keeping with the historical character of the area, and the need for larger affordable family homes as opposed to flats.

The existing supermarket is an essential amenity for local residents and is the only large supermarket in the area. It's close proximity to many existing homes means people can use more sustainable transport methods.

The development would cause huge inconvenience to existing homes, and possibly structural issues as they are old homes. It would also greatly increase traffic on the already congested green lanes, and increase demand on stretched local public transport services, schools and health care.

Sainsburys park is a well used green space essential for local health and well being.
