I wish to object to the develop of Green Belt land as well as to the application to develop the land known as Sainsburys Green Lanes N21 3R. All this is being done in the name of the "housing crisis". I am a homelessness professional advisor very familiar with the issues. The reality is:

- There is NO NEED to sacrifice community amenities that will be lost forever
- The crisis exists ONLY in respect of good quality accommodation for people on very low incomes who need benefits help to pay the rent. There is no crisis of availability of homes for people with higher incomes.
- Only accommodation affordable to low-income families, especially larger homes, need to be built.
- Population growth projections are out of date and do not factor-in the considerable shift of middle class populations away from london and to greener locations.

It is difficult not to get a feeling that the current policies and plans are little more than a golden ticket for commercial developers, to the detriment of ordinary residents.
