

Dear sir/madam

I wish to formally lodge my objections to the proposal in Enfield to significantly build on the green belt as part of the planning decision to create 25k new homes

I really don't see how this level of development is necessary in the first place and the types of homes this type of development brings will be expensive property which will do little to address any issues of adequate supplies of affordable housing

I also really don't agree with the proposal to use an existing school site in the centre of Enfield where St Anne's school is currently located

Especially as the plan is to build a skyscraper which will be massively out of character with the rest of buildings in Enfield

This plan smacks to me of a revenue generation scheme by the council rather than a considered strategic plan and needs to be totally reconsidered and evaluated by outside agencies to ensure it is fit for purpose and genuinely in the public interest

I do not accept the basic premise of the plan that so many new houses are essentially needed in Enfield in the first place
