First of all I object to the following Policies: SP PL10, pages 80-87, and Figure 3.11; Policy SP PL9, pages 77-80 and Concept Plan Figure 3.10; Policy SA45: Land Between Camlet Way and Crescent Way, Hadley Wood, page 364; Policy SA54, page 374; and Policy SA62 page 383 and SP CL4 pages 277-279 – all of which propose the dedesignation of Green Belt for housing and other purposes. These are beautiful, scenic, important and historic areas within Enfield Chase, and vitally important to Enfield overall. I believe it would be a huge loss not only to Enfield's Green belt but also detrimental to the aesthetics and character of our lovely town.
