Thank you for preparing our draft local plan. I would wish to register my objections to this in the strongest possible way as the health and well being of our citizens is of the highest order.

Thus I must register objections to
Policy SP PL 10, pages 80-87 Building 3000 homes on the Green Belt
Policy SP PL 9, pages 77-80. Building 3000 homes at Crews Hill
Policy SA45, page 364. Building 160 homes at Hadley Wood
Policy SA 54, page 374 industrial buildings on agricultural land

Enfield's unique status and environment is extremely fragile and vulnerable. If the Council enforces further development into the Greenbelt and surrounds this precious habitat will be lost forever, not only to us but to future generations.

Utilising every brownfield site is the only option when what is required is housing for families with children and services, including good schools, adequate health facilities and healthy air. Thus other alternatives need to be addressed.

This is also the case for objecting to

This proposal will undermine the current community facilities, especially for older and disabled people. Again, there appears no detail for any vital infrastructure such as health and education giving a lower quality of life.

I do strongly urge the Council to rethink their plans and consider all these elements before we start to destroy our environment even further.
