I am contacting you to request that you remove all reference to Firs Farm wetlands from Policy SP CL4.

I object to draft policy DM BG16 in the Draft Enfield Local Plan, which allocates Firs Farm Wetlands (Site ID SA59) as a site for burial and/or cremation use.

The site is very close to residential homes and does not seem a suitable position for cremation use.

I oppose this policy because Firs Farm wetlands is an important community resource, essential to the health and well-being of local people. The site has been developed in recent years and has been used by many more local people since then.
