I am writing this email to strongly object to the proposal of developing 160 homes on Green Belt Land in Hadley Wood.

We have been visiting Hadley Wood for many years as it such a beautiful part of the country. We also have close family living on Camlet Way who we visit on a regular basis and hence we were extremely concerned when we first heard about this proposal.

My main objection is that this development would completely destroy a valued part of the Green Belt. I do not understand why this wouldn't be protected at all costs.
