I wish to say that you must not permit ANY development on any part of the Enfield Green belt. Once such land is gone it's gone forever and bad for us now, for future generations and the Planet.

There are plenty of brownfield sites crying out for redevelopment. More imaginative developments could include ensuring a sufficient number of homes for downsizing, thus releasing larger family homes. The GLA rejects building on green belt plan and you should not ignore their views.
