I'd like to register my objection to SA32, Sainsburys Green Lanes N21 3RS. Page 351 of Enfield Local Plan. Redevelopment of supermarket and car park to mixed-use homes and non-residential floor space.

I feel that this supermarket provides an essential retail space in the area, with limited other large supermarkets within walking distance of this part of Palmers Green/Winchmore Hill. It also provides large numbers of jobs to people in the local community. In addition I understand that one of the conditions when Sainsburys was built there was to ensure the space served the community.

If Sainsburys are not going to continue to have a store at this site could the council consider building a primary school there - there is definitely a need for another primary school in the area and this would better serve the community. Additional housing would put pressure on the already struggling local infrastructure and resources including transport, health and education.
