To whom it may concern,

I am writing to you to raise my objection to the proposed plan of building on the Sainsbury's car park. I understand the need for more housing, but I feel that building housing here would be a very poor decision.

- 1. This is a big supermarket and therefore where a lot of people go to do their main shop. The car park is essential to families, and elderly people, who would struggle to bring a big shop home on public transport.
- 2. With the Fords Grove car park going and 14% of car parking on Winchmore Hill Broadway having gone, this development will lead to further loss of revenue to local shops, leading to potential closures.
- 3. If there is more housing here, it may mean more vehicles in this area from new residents, increasing carbon monoxide levels, impacting locals & particularly children at Highfields primary school.
- 4. Construction here will be so disruptive to traffic flow on Green Lanes, which can already be so busy.
