

I note that there are proposals to redevelop 7 supermarket sites.

Where do you propose the existing and new residents will shop for food? Perhaps we can go to Brookfield Farm. What are your proposals for creating jobs in the Borough for those currently employed in the supermarkets?

It is pointless creating new homes if you are not creating new jobs for the residents.

Whilst Edmonton Green and Palace Gardens are being redeveloped, (and I believe the plan states this will take 5 - 10 years), you will drive more people to shop on line or elsewhere. You may find you will have difficulty letting the new shopping space you provide.

The draft Local Plan is one to create more homes in the borough, but in doing so you are severely diminishing the quality of life of existing residents, and not providing for new residents.

A future Enfield will have little green space, fewer supermarkets, less shops and leisure facilities, fewer job opportunities, overstretched hospitals/GP surgeries/schools, congested roads, congested public transport etc., etc., etc.,

I could not see your proposals to improve the infrastructure along with building more homes. Perhaps the Council wants a quick fix, but I wonder if the new Enfield will be a place its creators will want to live?
