

Dear Enfield Council,

I am writing to express my strong objection to the draft plan to convert winchmore hill sainsbury in to mixed use housing and retail.

Doing this would be hugely disruptive to the 1,000s of people who use the supermarket on a regular basis. It is also likely to include the removal of the green space that surrounds sainsbury. I regularly walk to sainsbury and use the paths around to lengthen my walk, especially when I'm with my children, to encourage them to exercise and limit car use. There are benches around the site that people use frequently as a meeting space with friends.

There are commercial sites on the A10, such as the old Toys r us retail unit that could be used to create more housing alongside landscaping. This would improve the environment in the area whereas removing the green space around sainsbury would damage it.

I would be very grateful if the views of my family and I are taken into consideration.
