Local plan – Site SA45 – Land between Camlet Way and Crescent West, Hadley Wood

I have lived in Hadley Wood for a considerable number of years and regularly walk along the fields off Bartram's Lane. I am disappointed of the thought of possibly losing this beautiful green belt asset for such development.

I am strongly objecting to the proposal for the release of this green belt site and the site allocation, that would allow the development of 160 homes on green belt land for the following grounds.

- 1. SAVE OUR GREEN BELT.** The Green Belt must be protected and conserved as it serves vital purposes including separation from Barnet and Potters Bar, helping air quality in the borough and
- 2. CLIMATE CHANGE.** As a car-dependent location Hadley Wood is not a suitable location for a large-scale increase in housing at site SA45 or through intensification. The already existing congestion would be worsened, leading to air pollution
