

Local plan – Site SA45 – Land between Camlet Way and Crescent West, Hadley Wood

I have lived in Hadley Wood for a considerable number of years and regularly walk along the fields off Bartram's Lane. I am disappointed of the thought of possibly losing this beautiful green belt asset for such development.

I am strongly objecting to the proposal for the release of this green belt site and the site allocation, that would allow the development of 160 homes on green belt land for the following grounds.

LAND WILL DESTROY OUR UNIQUE HERITAGE LANDSCAPE. The Hadley Wood meadows under threat are part of the established Green Belt in an Area of Special Character across three boroughs. They provide visual harmony for many walkers and cyclists, are the setting for two Conservation Areas and their loss would greatly harm the heritage value of both Hadley Wood and Monken Hadley. The intensification plans would also cause harm to the Conservation Area.

The site is surrounded by Conservation Areas and Grade II listed buildings.
